

Rent comparables in Sacramento, CA

The monthly rent for an apartment in Sacramento, CA is \$1,650. A 1-bedroom apartment in Sacramento, CA costs about \$1,613 on average, while a 2-bedroom apartment is \$1,955. Houses for rent in Sacramento, CA are more expensive, with an average monthly cost of \$2,445.


